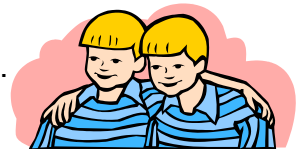
ADOPT A CLUB UPDATE

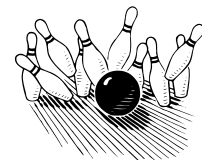
AWANA GRAND PRIX ON NOV. 14
