If you could ask God one question about heaven, what would you ask?

- **What will we be like in heaven?**
Do you remember a time when you felt really good about yourself and sensed that you were pleasing to God, using your talents, having a servant heart, and encouraging others? Can you imagine yourself the way God fully intends you to be in heaven?
- Read Romans 7:15-19. Can you relate to Paul's struggle? Can you envision a time when sin will no longer have a hold over you? What would it be like to not struggle with sin, physical ailments, weariness, etc.?
- **How old will we be in heaven?**
The Bible does not give us an answer to this question. Why do you think that is? What age would you like to be in heaven? Do you think there are children and infants in heaven or will we be at our optimal age?
- **Will we know each other in heaven?**
What examples were given in this message that answers this question? Look up the following verses if you need help: 2 Samuel 12:22,23, Luke 22:17-18, Matthew 17: 1-4. What other examples from scripture can you give?
- **Will I be married to the same person in heaven?**
Pastor Welsh stated "God created marriage because man needed a _____, woman needed a _____, and together they were to produce _____." Will these same functions/needs be necessary in heaven? Who will we be married to?

APPLICATION:

- Start a discussion this week with your child, friend, family member, or co-worker about heaven. If they are a believer, share what you have learned. If they are an unbeliever try asking them questions like "do you ever think of heaven?... do you think heaven is a real place?... what do you think heaven will be like?"
