ten reasons why heaven will be amazing

Imagine there is a heavenly "Starbucks" and you can meet any bible character there for coffee and hear their personal story and ask them any question you want. Who would you choose and why?



- Which of the "ten reasons given for why heaven will be amazing", most excites you or was something you learned that you didn't know about heaven?
- Did you ever consider that you will have **responsibilities in heaven** and that God will use you to operate His heavenly kingdom? In light of this information....
 - 1) Do you know what your spiritual gift(s) are?
 - 2) Does your age matter as far as when you learn about your gifts or when you start to use them?
 - 3) Is your earthly education/training going to be wasted or end when you reach heaven?
 - 4) How does knowing that your faithfulness to use your spiritual gifts in this life will determine the responsibilities you will be given in heaven, motivate you to serve God and others?
- Pastor Welsh talked about the "**no-mores**" (Revelation 7:16-17). What is one "no-more" that you will be so glad to never have to deal with again?
- Read Philippians 2:9-11. **The last time we fall**. What will be the difference between the emotions/thoughts of believers and unbelievers at this scene?

APPLICATION – *Living out what you have learned during your week....*

- Are you looking forward to seeing Jesus? Are you using your spiritual gifts? Do you have a better eternal perspective after this series? Take time this week to fall on your knees and thank God for the "living hope" (I Peter 1:3) you have in Christ and the promise of heaven.
