Awana Games and Sparks-A-Rama

Dear Awana Parents and Guardians,

The Regional Awana Games and Sparks-A-Rama are just around the corner. Both events will be held at Valley Center High School on February 6, 2010 in the morning.

Awana Games is a competition for third to sixth graders where churches in the region compete by playing 10 games that they normally play during game time in Awana. It is very structured and we encourage family and friends to come and root on their child and his/her team. For Awana Games there will be a girls team and a boys team with at least 10 on each but not more than 12 kids. If we don't get 20 clubbers to go, we can have a co-ed team with at least 5 boys and 5 girls. Sparks-A-Rama is for the kindergarten to second grade clubbers and is not nearly as competitive. They will play 6 games against the other churches. Sparks-A-Rama teams are co-ed and consist of at least 15 but not more than 17 kids.

There will be four practices on January 9, 16, 23 and 30. Clubbers will need to attend at least 2 of the four practices in order to be a part of our team. There will be a parents meeting on January 9 during the first practice to inform the parents about the events and what is expected of the clubbers.

Since the Awana Games and Sparks-A-Rama are being held earlier this year, we need to get a good idea of how many clubbers are interested before Christmas break so make the necessary preparations. Please complete, sign, and return the attached permission form no later than December 16. You will need one form per child. Since we will be limited on team size, the teams will be filled on a first come, first served basis. So the earlier you get the forms back to us, the greater the chances are that your child will get a position on the team. We will have a few alternate positions in case of a child gets sick and play on February 6. Alternates still need to attend the practices.

Like years in the past, there will also be free team t-shirts provided by Jay Storey, owner of Furniture On Consignment. Please indicate your child's t-shirt size on the permission form. The t-shirts will be distributed on February 3 at the end of Awana.
