## ■ day one { impossible neutrality }

**What are some areas that you feel that it is impossible to be neutral?** When an individual is confronted with Jesus – when they understand who He is and what He claims – it is impossible to remain neutral. How do you relate to the above statement? As a believer in Christ do you still have times that although you understand the Lord’s direction, you still would like to be neutral? Think about some of those times and the reasons for your strong resistance to follow Christ’s leading. How can you overcome this area of weakness and spiritual warfare?

## ■ day two { the right thing }

**Is it always right to do the right thing, regardless of how we feel?** How do you go about determining what is the right thing? What part do you think feelings have to do with a majority of our decision-making? Several years ago a Christian singer sang the words “how can it be wrong if it feels so right.” What does this say about the way we can “reason to sin?” Think about some things that feel right but are not necessarily the right thing to do. Ask God to help you be discerning.

## ■ day three { good news }

**Where were you when you first heard the good news of the gospel of Jesus Christ? Do you remember how you responded?** The good news is that Jesus brings hope for the broken-hearted and those held captive by their sins. Find some scriptures that give us the basis and meaning of this “good news!” Where were you going before you heard the “good news?” Where might you be today if you would not have heard and responded? How can this help you to have boldness to share God’s ‘good news’ with those who you know are so lost?

## ■ day four { faith and miracles }

**Has there been a time when God performed a miracle in your life because of your faith?** There must be faith before there can be miracles. Read all of Hebrews 11. Now go back and reread verse 11. How does this verse and this chapter communicate what God can and will do through the lives of believers? Read about “expectant living” in Romans 8:18-28...what do these verses communicate about where we place our hope?

## ■ day five { the Grace of God }

**What are some of the things that make our church special? Is it the people, the preaching, the music?** Despite our desire to keep the church special, only admitting those who look like act and us like us; the grace of God is offered to everyone on the face of the earth. Think about the problems we have as Christians getting caught up in relationships that only make us feel good. Christian friendships are certainly important, but how can your life impact a lost soul who is headed for hell? What is the Lord saying to you in terms of your witness to others? Read Romans 8:1-4
