

Characteristic	Isa in Islam	False Prophet in Christianity
Position	Subordinate to al-Mahdi. Lower in status than al-Mahdi. Help al-Mahdi achieve his goals.	Subordinate to Antichrist. Lower in status than Antichrist. Help Antichrist achieve his goals.
Function	A prominent religious leader. Helps al-Mahdi institute Islam over world. All other religions will be abolished.	A prominent religious leader. Helps Antichrist institute world religion over world. No other religion allowed.
Religion	Direct people to worship Allah	Direct people to worship "dragon"
Laws	Help al-Mahdi to institute Shari'a Law and Islamic calendar	Help Antichrist to change laws and times
Behavior	Will claim to be the real Jesus, and act like him. Lying allowed under certain circumstances according to Sunnah of Muhammad.	Horns like a lamb (exercises authority like Jesus), speak like a dragon (lies and leading people astray and away from God)
Christianity	Will abolish Christianity	Will direct all to follow Antichrist and his religion.
Proselytization	Will persuade many Christians to become Muslims	Will lead many astray from Jesus and God of the Bible. There will be a great falling away (the Great Apostasy) in the End Times.
Persecution	Persecutes and kills Jews and Christians	Persecutes and kills Jews and Christians who refuse to follow Antichrist and him
Miracles	As a prophet, will possibly be able to perform miracles	Performs astounding miracles
"Mark of the Beast"	A beast will mark the Muslims on the forehead to distinguish from non-Muslims.	Institute the mark on the forehead or right hand so that only those who have the mark can buy and sell.
Slayer	Isa will kill ad-Dajjal.	Antichrist will kill the Two Witnesses.

Special characteristics	Has the letters "kfr" (kafir, meaning infidel) on forehead	Wears sackcloth signifying repentance (Heb: "kpr". In Hebrew, the letter "p" is the same as "f")	Rev. 11:3
Location	Appears between Iraq and Syria	Not stated, but likely in Israel and other places	
Followers	Leader of 70,000 Isfahan Jews and women.	Not stated, likely a Jew and a Christian witness. No mention of followers	
Vocation	Will claim to be a prophet	Prophecy, hence designated as prophets.	Rev 11:3
Ministry	Oppose al-Mahdi, Muslims and lead people away from Islam	Oppose Antichrist, the world and lead people away from the world religion. Lead people into repentance to the God of the Bible.	Rev 11:3,7
Ministry	Preach and torment Muslims for "40 days". Due to unusual length of certain days, it is actually (or perceivably) about 14 months long.	Preach and torment Antichrist's followers for 1260 days (about 42 months, 3.5 years)	Rev 11:5,6
Miracles	Performs great miracles, esp. sends and withholds rain.	Perform great miracles, esp. withhold rain.	Rev 11:5,6
Death	Killed by Isa	Killed by Antichrist	Rev 11:7
Death	Killed in Ludd (near Tel Aviv, Israel)	Bodies lie in Jerusalem (inside Israel)	Rev 11:8
Reactions to Death	No doubt there will be rejoicing by Muslims. Giving of sweets/gifts is a M.E. custom	Rejoicing by the world. Giving of gifts.	Rev 10
Burial	Not buried. Simply disappear.	Bodies lay unburied for 3.5 days, then resurrected to heaven.	Rev. 11:11-12
